HOLY Communion

Communion : Reminds us that Jesus DESTROYED the Devil through DEATH to DELIVER US

Heb 2:14-15 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Col 2:13-15 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, <u>hath He quickened together with Him</u>, <u>having forgiven you all</u> <u>rtrespasses</u>; <u>Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us</u>, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross; And having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it. (*Rom 8:11*)

Luk 10:17-18 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

Rev 12:7-9 And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.



Rev 12:10-11 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. (*Rev 12:17 – Have the Testimony of Jesus, Rev 19:10, Rev 1:2,9*) **Heb 1:3** Who (*Jesus*) being the brightness of His (*God's*) glory, and the express image of His (*God's*) person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Col 1:21-22 And you, being in time past alienated and enemies in your mind in your evil works, yet now hath He reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy and without blemish and unreproveable before Him:

1Cor 15:25-26 For He must reign, till He hath put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. **Rev 1:17-18** And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. And He laid His right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death. (*Mat 28:18, 16:19, 18:18*)

For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are [symbolically] proclaiming [the fact of] the Lord's death until He comes [again]. So then whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in a way that is unworthy [of Him] will be guilty of [profaning and sinning against] the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eats and drinks damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened (rebuked) of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord <u>Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread</u>; <u>and when He had given thanks, He</u> broke it and said, 'Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in (Affectionate) remembrance of Me.' (Isa 53:5, 1 Cor 11:24 – His Body was Broken for us, offered as a SACRIFICE for us) 1 Cor 11:24 Amp

And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "<u>Drink from it, all of you;</u> for this is My blood of the [new and better] covenant, which [ratifies the agreement and] is being poured out for many [as a substitutionary atonement] for the forgiveness (remission) of sins." (Also Refer to: 1 John 1:7,9 – His Blood Cleanses us of all unrighteousness, Heb 10:17-18 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. & Heb 10:22 – Hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience)
