Then Jesus declared,

"I AM the
BREAD
of LIFE;

He who comes to me will
never go hungry, and he
who believes in me will
never be thirsty.

John 6:35



Isa 53:5 But He was wounded (pierced through) for our transgressions (*rebellion*), He was bruised (bruises that cut in) for our iniquities (Twistedness, Deception): the chastisement (verbal & Physical REBUKE) of our peace (SHALOM) was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed.

What determines the Price of an item... ??

The VALUE of any item is determined by the JOY that it will provide !!!

Heb 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; **Who for the JOY that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame (*reproach, offence*)**, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

1Jn 1:5-7 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: **But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin.**

1Jn 1:8-9: **If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

1Jn 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

For I received from the Lord Himself that [instruction] which I passed on to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is (represents) My body, which is [offered as a sacrifice] for you. Do this in [affectionate] remembrance of Me."

In the same way, after supper He took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant [ratified and established] in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in [affectionate] remembrance of Me."

For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are [symbolically] proclaiming [the fact of] the Lord's death until He comes [again].

So then whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in a way that is unworthy [of Him] will be guilty of [profaning and sinning against] the body and blood of the Lord.
