
Communion and Pentecost



For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are [symbolically/Prophetically] proclaiming [the fact/TRUTH of] the Lord's death until He comes [again]. So then whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in a way that is unworthy [of Him] will be guilty of [profaning and sinning against] the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eats and drinks damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened (rebuked) of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world. 1 Cor 11:26-32 AMP/KJV

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, 'Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in (Affectionate) remembrance of Me.' (Isa 53:5, 1 Cor 11:24 – His Body was Broken for us, offered as a SACRIFICE for us) 1 Cor 11:24 Amp

And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "<u>Drink from it, all of you;</u> for this is My blood of the [new and better] covenant, which [ratifies the agreement and] is being poured out for many [as a substitutionary atonement] for the forgiveness (remission) of sins." (Also Refer to: 1 John 1:7,9 – His Blood Cleanses us of all unrighteousness,. & Heb 10:22 – Hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience) Matthew 26: 26-30 Amp
